FIDA Sustainability Diploma accreditation progress

The important news this month is that our Sustainability Diploma is going forward for ratification as a national qualification credit-rated at SCQF Level 6, equivalent to one Higher. This exciting development is a tribute to the hard work of our staff team and excellent support from Glasgow Clyde College and the University of Stirling. The Diploma will be piloted in the 2024-25 session with a selection of schools from across Scotland, including Dollar Academy.
