This month saw the formal launch of our International Sustainability Diploma in four schools that are piloting the course in the 2024/25 session: Inverness Royal Academy, Speyside High, Alloa Academy and Braes High (Falkirk). They will be joined in August by Clifton Hall School in Edinburgh and, of course, Dollar Academy. It is very encouraging to see such a wide geographical spread of schools, indicating the breadth of interest in the new qualification. The pilot will provide valuable experience and insight as we prepare to offer the Diploma more widely in 2025/26.
