FIDA Diploma pilot is underway

We are very pleased to share that a further school - Our Lady & St Patrick's in Dumbarton – has joined the pilot of our new Diploma qualification. We are looking forward to hosting teachers from OLSP as well as our other six pilot schools next week for a day of training and feedback on progress so far. Forty Diploma students (around half of the student cohort) will also attend a full-day workshop led by the Enterprise Team from the University of Stirling, a key part of the course. The second group of students will attend their Enterprise session later in September.
